# Behind on rent?

### Rent Relief Programs Are Here to Help

COVID-19 has affected individuals in each state. There are emergency funds available to help renters pay current and past due rent and utility bills.

Households must have income at or below their state and local requirements for rent relief, and meet other eligibility requirements.

Check with your local rent resources for specific details.

#### PLEASE NOTE:

Requirements and coverage will vary by state. Please refer to your applicable state/local rent relief program for all qualification and requirement details.



### What costs does the program cover?

The various Rent Relief programs vary on coverage by state and region, with many costs covered as far back as March, 2020 - depending on local details.

#### Costs covered *may* include:

- Past due, current and some upcoming expected rent and/or utility costs

#### Gather the following materials:

- Government or other personal ID
- Copy of rent or lease agreement
- Notices of late rent payments or notice to evict, if applicable.
- Copies of past-due utility bills, if utility assistance is being requested.
- Income documentation for all household members above the age of 18 (or head/cohead of house if under age 18) (2019 and 2020 tax returns/3 months of pay stubs and bank statements).
- Unemployment letter(s).
