**MARY POPPINS RETURNS** In Depression-era London, a now-grown Jane and Michael Banks, along with Michael's three children, are visited by the enigmatic Mary Poppins (**Emily Blunt**) following a personal loss. Through her unique magical skills, and with the aid of her friend Jack, she helps the family rediscover the joy and wonder missing in their lives.

**BEN IS BACK** Nineteen-year-old Ben Burns unexpectedly returns to his family's suburban home on Christmas Eve. Ben's mom, Holly, is relieved and welcoming but wary of her son's drug addiction. Over a turbulent 24 hours, new truths are revealed, and a mother's undying love gets put to the test as Holly does everything in her power to keep Ben clean. **Julia Roberts** stars.

**MORTAL ENGINES** Hundreds of years after civilization was destroyed by a cataclysmic event, a mysterious young woman, Hester Shaw (**Hera Hilmar**), emerges as the only one who can stop London — now a giant, predator city on wheels — from devouring everything in its path. Feral, and fiercely driven by the memory of her mother, Hester joins forces with Tom Natsworthy (**Robert Sheehan**), an outcast from London, along with Anna Fang (**Jihae**), a dangerous outlaw with a bounty on her head.

**WELCOME TO MARWEN** When a devastating attack shatters Mark Hogancamp (**Steve Carell**) and wipes away all memories, no one expected recovery. Putting together pieces from his old and new life, Mark meticulously creates a wondrous town where he can heal and be heroic. As he builds an astonishing art installation—a testament to the most powerful women he knows—through his fantasy world, he draws strength to triumph in the real one.

**AQUAMAN** Jason Momoa stars as Aquaman, king of Atlantis, born half-human as Arthur Curry and half-Atlantean. When he learns that he is the heir to the underwater kingdom of Atlantis, and must step forward to lead his people and be a hero to the world.

**THE MULE** Broke, alone and facing foreclosure on his business, Earl Stone (**Clint Eastwood**) takes a job as a drug courier for a Mexican cartel. His immediate success leads to easy money and a larger shipment that soon draws the attention of hard-charging DEA agent Colin Bates (**Bradley Cooper**). When Earl's past mistakes start to weigh heavily on his conscience, he must decide whether to right those wrongs before law enforcement and cartel thugs catch up to him.

**SECOND ACT** Jennifer Lopez stars as a big box store employee who reinvents her life and her lifestyle, which gives her the chance to prove to Madison Avenue that street smarts are as valuable as a college degree.

**HOLMES & WATSON** Detective Sherlock Holmes (**Will Ferrell**) and Dr. John Watson (**John C. Reilly**) join forces to investigate a murder at Buckingham Palace. They soon learn that they have only four days to solve the case, or the queen will become the next victim.

**BUMBLEBEE** On the run in the year 1987, Bumblebee finds refuge in a junkyard in a small Californian beach town. Charlie, on the cusp of turning 18 and trying to find her place in the world, discovers Bumblebee, battle-scarred and broken.

**STAN & OLLIE** Laurel and Hardy (**John C. Reilly** and **Steve Coogan**), the world's most famous comedy duo, attempt to reignite their film careers as they embark on what becomes their swan song — a grueling theatre tour of post-war Britain.
