PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

All Antelope Ridge homes are required to have preventive maintenance work performed quarterly and annually. This work is required to ensure the safety and efficiency of the home and all provided appliances/systems. The Permission to Enter Addendum (PTE) signed with your lease specifies PTE for maintenance requested by the resident not for required maintenance. Preventive maintenance is required.

When necessary, residents will be contacted to schedule all preventive maintenance work when access to the interior of the home is required. A notice may be sent in lieu of the phone call notifying the resident of the date of service. If residents are not home at the scheduled time of service, Antelope Ridge's representative will make entry and complete the required maintenance. The resident must contact the Maintenance Office to reschedule a time for the work to be completed.
