UPDATES AND REMINDERS FROM OUR MANAGEMENT OFFICE

Happy Summer to everyone! We hope you are enjoying the long days and sunshine. We have a lot going on—so if you have questions, don't hesitate to call! Below is some information and reminders to help everyone enjoy this season and stay informed!

BURLINGTON TELECOM

The long-awaited Burlington Telecom work will be starting this month at Northgate! You will soon have another provider (if you choose) for your phone, internet and cable. Keep watching for information coming to you from Burlington Telecom their various programming options and rates.

ONGOING EXTERIOR WORK

If your building is one of the ones having exterior siding installed this year, please pay close attention to notices sent from the management office. These notices will tell you when the contractor will be working on your building and what you need to do to prepare. If you have any questions, please contact Titus Valoricristo at ext. 16.

Also, a safety reminder to parents to be sure you children are not playing in the areas of the work being done.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE INSPECTIONS

As staff continues to complete our annual preventive maintenance inspections in each apartment, a reminder to be certain that all rooms are accessible for this important inspection. Also, if you have an assistance animal, please be certain that it is either out of the unit, crated or being held by a responsible party for the duration of the inspection.

RENT PAYMENTS

As residents at Northgate, it is a requirement of your lease that you pay your rent each month on the first of the month. Any rent payments received after the 5th of each month are considered <u>late</u> payments. It is important for the financial well-being of the property that every household pay their rent on time each month. (and remember, any future landlord or mortgage references will ask if the applicant has made their payments on time!)

ITEMS ATTACHED TO NEW TRIM

We have noticed that some households have attached various items to the new trim on the buildings.

The notice that was sent to every household prior to the beginning of the work on each building very clearly states: "After the new wood trim has been installed and per the Northgate Home Improvement Policy there is to be no drilling or nailing into the vinyl siding, outside trim or fencing."

Please be advised that if you have installed these items they need to be removed immediately.

ASSISTANCE DOG OWNERS!

A reminder to all assistance dog owners: Please make sure you clean up after your dog! It's very annoying and unsanitary for other residents to be stepping in dog waste!! Also, your backyard area must ALWAYS be clean of dog waster !
