# **Roasted Beet Citrus Salad**

1. Preheat the oven to 400°F.

2. Wrap each beet in aluminum foil with a drizzle of olive oil and generous pinches of salt and pepper.

- 3. Place the wrapped beets on a baking sheet and roast until they're fork-tender. Mine usually take 35-60 minutes the time will depend on the size and freshness of your beets.
- 4. Unwrap the beets and set them aside to cool.
- 5. When they're cool to the touch, rub off the skins. Do
- this step under running water for easy cleanup!

6. Make a vinaigrette from a few splashes of sherry or balsamic vinegar, fresh orange and lemon juice, and a few pinches of salt and pepper.
