Answer to: "Who Am I?"

David O' Selznick was an American film producer, screenwriter and film studio executive. He is best known for producing "*Gone with the Wind*" (1939) & "*Rebecca*" (1940), both of which earned him an Academy Award for Best Picture. In his younger working career, despite his output of successful movies at MGM, Paramount & then RKO movie studios, Selznick longed to be an independent producer with his own studio.

In 1935 he realized that goal by leasing RKO Culver City Studios & back lot, formed Selznick International Pictures, and distributed his films through United Artists. His successes continued with classics such as "A Star is Born", "The Adventures of Tom Sawyer", "Intermezzo" & "Gone with the Wind". "*Gone with the Wind*" overshadowed the rest of Selznick's career. Later, he was convinced that he had wasted his life trying to outdo it. In 1930, Selznick was married to the daughter of Louis B. Mayer, Gladys. In 1949, he married actress Jennifer Jones. They had one daughter, Mary Jennifer Selznick, who committed suicide by jumping from a 20th-floor window in Los Angeles in 1976. Selznick was an amphetamine user. He died on June 22, 1965 at age 63 following several heart attacks, For his contribution to the motion picture industry, Selznick has a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.
