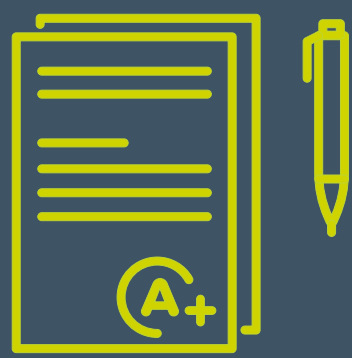
GIVING BACK
