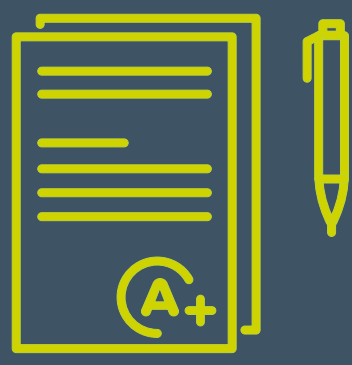
## GIVING BACK
