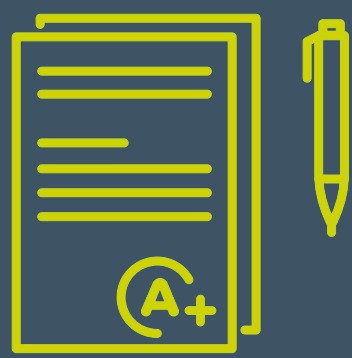
GIVING BACK
